**Principal's Report:** Things discovered from cycle 1

- SSP Goals
  - Literacy - most students were able to apply their understanding of fluency when UFLI fluency checks were completed, and they demonstrated growth in their oral reading ability. Students that were unsuccessful with these fluency checks are receiving ongoing letter-sound repetition (through LC and/or small groups). In grade 3/4, about 18 out of 22 are able to apply the skills to decode unknown words.
  - Math - ongoing conversations around growth mindset have been occurring, as, at first, many students were demonstrating a hesitancy around participating in flexible math learning as they felt anxious about having the wrong answer.
  - Well-being - classes have been exploring social-emotional learning with various supports- i.e. Primary, Little Spot program. All students are receiving support via various groupings and tier 1 support.
- School activities
  - Discovery Centre is coming January 24th to do workshops with each class in addition to a whole school presentation.
  - Oval skating February 4th

- Felt art painting in grade 4 in February
- Writer's Federation - author visits
- Hope for Wildlife will hopefully be at the school this Spring
- Fine arts facilitating school sign
- A new student-designed sign is being produced and will hopefully hang on the side of the school
